

LAGS' DRUG BAG

£35k heroin haul found in rucksack

DRUGS worth £35,000 have been found inside a prison in what is believed to be the largest ever haul smuggled behind bars.

The heroin and amphetamines were discovered with 34 mobile phones and sim cards in a rucksack that was attached to the perimeter fence at HMP Ranby, Notts.

Police have been called to investigate as worried staff fear a string of violent attacks by addicts going cold turkey.

Prison lawyer Joe Chapman, said: "Whoever is dealing inside is going to be in hot water, these drugs are paid for and people will have been waiting for them."

A Prison Service spokesperson said the stash was found due to "the vigilance of staff and the rigorous security in place".

Nottinghamshire Police added: "We can confirm a rucksack containing mobiles, sim cards and drugs was found at HMP Ranby. No arrests have been made."
